SELECTION CRITERIA

The Faculty of Education programs have been designed to select, through fair and equitable ways, the best possible candidates to become teachers, and to welcome diversity in those admitted.

Students are selected into Education using the following criteria for all programs:

- Academic Achievement – refers to a minimum admission average of 65.00%. Applicants who have not achieved the minimum admission average of 65.00% will not be reviewed
- Relevant experiences and community service, and
- Writing ability in relation to form and content

SELECTION PROCESS FOR TEACHER EDUCATION

1. Applicants will be placed in the relevant program admission competition. The number of spaces available in each program is limited.
2. Applicants will be selected according to the above stated criteria as interpreted by each program. Meeting minimum requirements is not necessarily sufficient to gain admission.
3. The Arts Education program, Baccalauréat en éducation program, and Elementary After Degree program (BEAD), as well as some Secondary program majors, may require interviews with applicants. Applicants will be contacted regarding scheduling of individual interviews.
4. The entrance requirements for the Bachelor of Music Education include those of **both** the Faculty of Education and the Faculty of Fine Arts.
5. The Music Education Program may require interviews with applicants. Applicants will be contacted regarding scheduling of individual interviews.
6. Transfer applicants who are admitted to the Faculty of Education, University of Regina will be granted credit for applicable university courses completed. A formal transfer credit evaluation will be calculated upon selection into a Teacher Education Program.
7. A limited number of spaces in each program will be available for students who identify themselves and are deemed appropriate for special consideration (see Section 3.3 of the TEAP).
8. Late applications will be considered on an individual first-come, first-serve basis as space permits.
9. Applicants should be aware that when applying to a teacher education program or at the completion of their degree for a teaching certificate, they are required to indicate if they have been convicted of, or charged with any criminal offence of a sexual nature, or involving a minor, and to authorize a criminal record search. When applying for a teaching certificate, applicants must also indicate if a teaching certificate has been suspended or previously denied.
